How Does It Work?

Each class will attend a viewing session and a buying session. During the viewing time, your student will create a "wish list" of new books they are interested in and will bring that list home. The classes will come back during a buying time and if you wish to purchase those books, please send in a check or cash with your student(s). Book buying will begin Wednesday and a flyer will be sent home with the day of their buying time.

The Book Fair will be open for our special evening time for FWES families to check out all the books and gifts. It's a great opportunity to see friends and find more books that are age and level appropriate for your young readers. Every student that attends Family Night will be entered into a special raffle to win book coupons and other fun prizes. An adult must accompany students to Family Night.

Our teachers also make wish lists to help build their classroom libraries. The lists will be displayed at the Book Fair. Book plates are available so that you may personalize the gifts from your teacher wish lists.
