- Gift of Time to Read-
 - At School: Building reading stamina is a gift we can give students that will assist them in completing End of Grade tests and prepare them for assignments in middle and high school that require extensive time and reading. Each classroom will designate at least 30 minutes for students to read each day of our Gift of Reading Celebration.
 - Reading Theme Days-
 - Thursday, December 13- Dress Like your Favorite Book Character
 - Friday, December 14- Flashlight Friday- bring a flashlight to read with when lights are off in your classroom
 - Monday, December 17- Mix-Matched Monday- mix and match shoes and socks
 - Tuesday, December 18- Tacky Sweater Tuesday- wear your favorite holiday shirts/sweaters
 - Wednesday, December 19- Wild Animal Wednesday- bring a stuffed animal to read with in your classroom
 - Thursday, December 20- Relax and Read! Wear your PJs for classroom reading
 - At Home: Students are asked to read for at least 20 minutes a night and record their minutes read on a Gift of Reading Reading log. All students who log at least 180 minutes read on their returned reading log (10 students in K-2 and in 3-5)will each win two new books to add to their collection.
