Welcome Back to Farmington Woods Elementary School!

1st-5th Graders Return to School Monday, August 28th

2017-18 School Hours: 9:15am-3:45pm Students may arrive between 8:45-9:15am each day; instruction begins at 9:15am

Open House Parking: We will have lots of cars for very few parking spaces at Open House. Security will be on campus to assist with parking in designated spots and on our back field. Families also have permission to use the church parking lot at Seabrook Ave and Cary Pkwy to park and walk to campus and avoid traffic and congestion. The busiest time is 8:00-8:45am so you might consider a later visit, to our campus.

Open House- Friday, August 25th from 8:30-11:00am

We are looking forward to starting the new school year and have been busy getting things ready! We will have many new students and their families joining our school family to learn from our exciting IB/PYP program.

1st-5th grade class rosters will be posted on the front windows on Thursday, August 24th at 4:30pm. Open House is scheduled for Friday, August 25th from 8:30am-11:00am to meet your teacher and complete many beginning of the year procedures and processes. The 2017-18 school year will begin for students in grades 1st through 5th on Monday, August 28, 2017.

Kindergarten parents should attend one of the Parent Orientation sessions offered on Aug. 25th (8:45am or 10:00m) and complete beginning of the year materials during Open House. Kindergarten students staggered entry will be from Aug 28-31. Kindergarten class rosters will be posted on Sept. 1 at 1:15 pm and Kindergarten Open House is Friday, Sept. 1st from 1:30-2:30pm.

With about 800 students, cooperation from all families is appreciated in using good neighbor judgment when parking on campus and in our neighborhood during our Open House event.

Taking care of Starting the Year Business at Open House...

In addition to seeing friends, making new ones and meeting your teacher; Open House is time to get all of the starting school business completed:

- •FWES Spiritwear will be on sale at Open House. Many shirts will be available to take home that day!
- •Agendas: Each 2nd-5th Grade student will need to purchase an agenda for \$3.00 each- look for the table near PTA.
- •Carpool tag registration forms are available on our website to complete and bring with you and will also be available for Familie's during Open House. All families who use carpool must register

for a NEW number each year to insure student safety at dismissal.

- •Bus route information will be posted on line for families to review. All NEW riders must register for a bus route before they will be allowed to ride a bus. You can register at <u>Bus Rider</u> Information and Registration. More information is included on page 2.
- •Volunteer registration will be available at Open House- sign up (or reactivate) to be a volunteer at FWFS!
- Lunch Account information will be available and families can put an initial amount on the child's lunch account to start the year.
- •Medications can be signed in at the Main Office. Remember that



the 1702 form must be completed by your physician and the medication must be in its prescription container before we can sign for it at the school.

NOTE: If you would prefer to drop off medication prior to open house, you may call the school to make an appointment- 919-460-3469 as only medication trained personnel may accept medication. The 1702 and medication in its prescription container must be brought to this appointment to complete the process.

- K Parents should attend the Parent Orientation Session on August 25 at 8:45am or 10:00am during Open House. This experience is meant to be for adults only- kindergartners should plan to attend their own Open House on September 1st.
- From August 28-Aug. 31 each kindergartner will attend school for one day as an orientation. This process allows for a 1:6 staff/student ratio to insure a positive first school experience. - **PTA Thank You!** Our PTA's fund raising efforts last year exceeded their goal and at the end of the year they were able to purchase new picnic tables for outside the cafeteria- so our visiting families at lunch have a great place to sit! - Bus Routes for 2017-18: All bus routes, stops and times will be available at <u>WCPSS</u> <u>Bus Routes</u> on August 18th. The school will not have information until these routes are published.
 - •Students must be assigned to a bus and bus stop in order to be allowed to ride a bus- assignments will be based on the student's home address on record.
 - •Students may NOT ride any other bus other than the one to which they are assigned
 - •Students who have not regularly ridden a bus previously who want to ride the bus this year (even if not daily) must register as a bus rider through the WCPSS website at: <u>Bus Rider</u> <u>Registration for 17-18</u>

•Curriculum Night 9/14: The school staff is excited to welcome all parents to a Curriculum and Information Night on September 14th; K-2 from 5:30-6:15pm; PTA General Membership Meeting 6:25-6:50 and; 3-5 from 7:00-7:45pm evening will provide families with information about the curriculum standards from your child's grade level team and the classroom expectations and procedures from your child's teacher. All other specialists and special areas teachers will also be available that night to share information and answer questions. Please mark your calendar for this important parent learning night and PTA budget review and voting.

- <u>Carpool Process</u>: The carpool process at FWES provides a safe way for students to be picked up each afternoon and takes about 20-25 minutes to load the 300+ cars that come through the lane each day. Please note, however, that the first 2-4 weeks of school are when the process can take up to 40 minutes, as students are learning their new numbers and our new families and students are learning the process. Adults will **NOT** be allowed to check students out from the carpool holding area in the cafeteria if the child is registered as a carpooler. Please be patient and remain in line in your car until your student can be loaded safely.
- Carpool Tags: Students are issued NEW numbers each year- so all families will need to complete a carpool registration form to get carpool tags at Open House. Families without 2017-18 school issued carpool tags displayed will have to pull over and sign the child out in the office after showing proper identification.
- Walker Dismissal Reminders: Our school has increased the number of students dismissed as walkers the last few years. This increase has put an extreme strain on available parking and on our relationship with the Kildare Farm community. Please note that families who choose to drive to our school to meet 'walkers" at the front entrance for dismissal should be respectful of the school's neighbors if you park in the neighborhood. For the safety of all pedestrians, those waiting to meet students at the front of the school will be asked to leave the area as soon as your child has been picked up so that carpool may begin to flow quickly and safely. Safety patrol will ring a triangle to notify the front porch that carpool is beginning and school staff will ask any remaining families to move down the sidewalk. In addition, families wishing to stay and play with friends will need to use the K-1 playground by the villas as the front playground is not be available during dismissal.

More information is available on the school website and will be sent home the first week of school. Thank you for your cooperation!

- Specials for 17-18: As we shared at the end of the school year, we have had to make adjustments to our specials and our specials schedule due to the K-3 class size law. Students will no longer have additional Science or Technology time as specials. We will, however, be using some specials time for other learning experiences that support our school and IB program such as IB Attitudes and Attributes lessons, Inquiry and Research lessons in the İnquiry center and Chinese Culture Lessons. In addition, we will be providing each grade level with the opportunity to use garden beds within the context of their learning objectives. Integrated technology will continue as part of the learning experience in the classroom as we look forward to the Elementary roll out of new devices to provide at least a 1:3 ratio in all classrooms.
- Scheduling Specials: As our grade levels will vary from 4 teachers to 7, we will have some variations in our specials schedule this year that are still being configured. Final information on the rotations for each grade level will be shared through your child's teacher at the start of the year.
- Walk to School Fridays! Walk to school Fridays will continue into the 2017-18 school year on the 1st Friday of each month, beginning Friday, September 1st! Families meet Mr. Eller in the parking lot of Kildaire Plaza at 8:30am and enjoy a wonderful walk through the greenway to FWES. We hope you'll plan to join him that 1st week of school!

FWES School Improvement Plan 2016-18

The School Improvement Plan (SIP) is a document that guides the work of our school community as we grow IB learners. Families are a vital part of the learning that occurs at Farmington Woods. The plan was developed last spring based on student achievement data and trends that indicate areas where our school can improve to support student success. Our plan includes an academic goal that is supported by key processes and action steps that will be implemented over the course of the next two years to support our school in achieving our goal. In addition, to monitor our progress, the plan and data related to the plan is reviewed quarterly so revisions can be made if and as needed. The team will meet at least quarterly to review student data trends, instructional practices and monitor the implementation of the current SIP. Parent input and review is important to this process. - All members of the School Improvement Team, staff and parents, must be voted in to represent their respective groups. Once your interest is expressed, your name will be shared with our PTA and the PTA will present you for a vote to serve at the PTA Meeting on September 14th. - All 2nd-5th Graders will need to pay \$3 for the school agenda to the Farmington Woods PTA- bring payment to Open House on 8/25 and pay in the cafeteria through PTA.
- ⇒ Due to new health/medical mandates, Field Trip permission slips must be returned at least 30 days prior to the field trip.
- ⇒ Clubs will be on Thursday mornings before school. Information will go home in September about the options for 17-18.
- Health Active Student guidelines make healthy snacks (pretzels, lowfat yogurt, fresh fruits and vegetables, graham crackers, etc.) a priority in the classroom when students bring a snack from home. Students will be limited to 2 snack purchases in the cafeteria for eating with lunch.
- Birthday recognitions are part of the school's daily routine for students. Families are asked to find time outside of the school day to celebrate birthdays. Due to allergies and high sugar content, treats at lunch are discouraged and required advance notice of the classroom teacher and approval. Many varied options for honoring students on their birthday are included in the handbook.
- ⇒ Last minute transportation changes made in person after 3:15pm at the front office are reserved for emergencies or unique situations and should not occur regularly.
- >> Walkers should exit campus by 3:50pm daily. Parents unable to meet students by 3:50pm will need to register and pick up students in the carpool line.
- Classroom Instructional time is a priority. Classrooms interruptions will be eliminated throughout the day for delivery of forgotten items

 teachers will have notes in their mailboxes about items dropped off and students may pickup forgotten items during their lunch time.
 Please remind students to bring homework, projects, jackets, etc. each morning.
- WCPSS Dress Code applies to all K-12 students. Back to school reminders for our students: sundresses/halter style shirts must be worn over a t-shirt or with a sweater; shorts/skirts must be fingertip length; sagging pants, spaghetti straps, excessively tight clothing, bare midriffs and exposed undergarments are not allowed. Due to daily physical activity, for student safety, flip flops should not be worn to school. Thank you for monitoring your child's dress each day to check for dress code compliance- especially in the warmer weeks at the start of the year!

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Continuing A Walk in the Woods ...

- Before/After School Applications: At this time, both the Before and After School programs are at full enrollment with many families on the waitlist. If additional staff are able to be added to the programs, vacancies will be filled first from the waitlist.
- On Line Lunch Account: Wake County Child Nutrition Services offers all families the option to pay on student lunch accounts through <u>www.myschoolbucks.com</u>. Using this service allows parents to pay with credit cards and access information about the purchases your child makes each day. It also sends email alert's when you'r child's lunch account ge'ts below \$5.00. The system has been upgraded from last year's mylunchmoney.com so look for the change when you log on, but your log in and password are the same.
- Safety Patrol Sign up: 4th and 5th grade students interested in serving on our Safety Patrol for the 17-18 school year can sign up at the Safety Patrol table during Open House. Many students are needed to assist in the mornings and afternoons with carpool. Training and scheduling of new students will take place the first few weeks of the school year.
- Student Accident Insurance: Accident insurance is the responsibility of each student's family. Information about student accident insurance is available on the WCPSS Website-Student Accident Insurance.

• Volunteer Registration:

Registration is available on any WCPSS computer from July 1st-October 30th 24 hrs a day. Beginning Nov. 1st registration is only available on Mondays from 8:00am-4:00pm. Volunteers may register in the school office- registration is open now when the school is open 8:30-11:45am and 1:00-4:00pm.

* Returning Registered Volunteers- Returning volunteers must reactivate his/her file through a simple process to remain on the approved volunteer list. Reactivation can be completed on a school computer. Those not reactivated by October '30th will be dropped from the approved list and will have to complete the new volunteer process to return to the list.

* Approved Volunteers New to FWES- We

welcome our new families. If you were an approved volunteer at another Wake County school in the 16-17 school year, you will need to re-activate your volunteer registration as soon as possible and make changes to your school list to include FWESso that your clearance appears on our school approval list. This reactivation and verification of your status on the FWES list, will be required prior to volunteering in our school.

* New Volunteers: All new volunteers to FWES are required to register and have a background check completed prior to volunteering. Background checks can take up to two weeks to be returned so new volunteers should register as soon as possible.
