Families also have permission to use the church parking lot at Seabrook Ave and Cary Pkwy to park and walk to campus and avoid traffic and congestion. The busiest time is 8:15-8:45am so you might consider a later visit, to our campus.

We are looking forward to starting the new school year and have been busy getting things ready! We will have many new students and their families joining our school family to learn from our exciting IB/PYP program.

1st-5th grade class rosters will be posted on the front windows on Thursday, August 23rd at 4:30pm. Open House is scheduled for Friday, August 24th from 8:30am-11:00am to meet your teacher and complete many beginning of the year procedures and processes. The 2018-19 school year will begin for students in grades 1st through 5th on Monday, August 27, 2018.

Kindergarten parents should attend one of the Parent Orientation sessions offered on Aug. 24th (8:45am or 10:15am) and complete beginning of the year materials during Open House. Kindergarten students staggered entry will be from Aug 27-30. Kindergarten class rosters will be posted on Aug. 31st at 1:15 pm and Kindergarten Open House is Friday, August 31st from 1:30-2:30pm.

With about 750 students, cooperation from all families is appreciated in using good neighbor judgment when parking on campus and in our neighborhood during our Open House event.

Taking care of Starting the Year Business at Open House...

In addition to seeing friends, making new ones and meeting your teacher; Open House is time to get all of the starting school business completed:

•**PTA Membership** information and on line registration information is included with this newsletter. At Open House, sign up for the many volunteer opportunities through the PTA.

•**FWES Spiritwear** will be on sale at Open House. Many shirts will be available to take home that day!

•**Agendas- Note Change for 18-19:** Only 5th Graders will use daily agendas in 2018-19. 5th grade families should pay \$4 for agendas (cash or check to FWES PTA) when visiting classrooms by using the envelope provided.

•**Carpool tag** registration forms are available on our website to complete and

bring with you and will also be available for families during Open House. All families who use carpool must register for a NEW number each year to insure student safety at dismissal.

•**Bus route information** will be posted on line for families to review. All NEW riders must register for a bus route before they will be allowed to ride a bus. You can register at [Bus Rider Information and Registration](#). More information is included on page 2.

•**Volunteer registration** will be available at Open House- sign up (or reactivate) to be a volunteer at FWES!

•**Lunch Account** information will be available and families can put an initial amount on the child's lunch account to start the year.



•**Medications can be signed in** at the Main Office. Remember that the 1702 form must be completed by your physician and the medication must be in its prescription container before we can sign for it at the school.

NOTE: If you would prefer to drop off medication prior to open house, you may call the school to make an appointment- 919-460-3469 as **only medication trained personnel may accept medication**. The 1702 and medication in its prescription container must be brought to this appointment to complete the process.

Kindergarten Student Staggered Entry

- K Parents should attend the Parent Orientation Session on August 24 at 8:45am or 10:15am during Open House. This experience is meant to be for adults only- kindergartners should plan to attend their own Open House on August 31st
- From August 27-Aug. 30 each kindergartner will attend school for one day as an orientation. This process allows for a 1:6 staff/student ratio to insure a positive first school experience. Kindergarten students have received information regarding staggered entry: Aug. 27 A-F; Aug. 28 G-L; Aug. 29 M-R; Aug. 30 S-Z. Parents AND Kindergartners are invited to Kindergarten Open House on **Friday, August 31st from 1:30-2:30pm** to meet your teacher.
- All kindergarten students will return on **Tuesday, September 4th following their Staggered Entry Day**. To help support parents' transition, on the first day of Kindergarten, there will be a **Transitions and Triumphs** event on **Tuesday, September 4th in the Inquiry Center at 9:20 am** after you drop your child off in kindergarten. Please plan to join our guidance counselors, administrators and your fellow kindergarten parents to learn more about Farmington Woods Kindergarten.

- **PTA Thank You!** Our PTA's fund raising efforts last year exceeded their goal and at the end of the year they were able to purchase new water bottle filling water fountains for our school- allowing students to more easily fill water bottles during the day and in the cafeteria. - **Bus Routes for 2018-19:** All bus routes, stops and times will be available at [WCPSS Bus Routes](http://WCPSSBusRoutes) on August 17th. The school will not have information until these routes are published.

- Students must be assigned to a bus and bus stop in order to be allowed to ride a bus- assignments will be based on the student's home address on record.
- Students may NOT ride any other bus other than the one to which they are assigned
- Students who have not regularly ridden a bus previously who want to ride the bus this year (even if not daily) must register as a bus rider through the WCPSS website at: [Bus Rider Registration for 18-19](http://BusRiderRegistrationfor18-19)



- **Backpack Bus Tags:** Starting last year and continuing this year, all bus riders in WCPSS

- elementary schools MUST have a bus tag on their book bag in order to load and ride the bus in the afternoons. The tag provides information that makes sure students are safe and dropped off at appropriate stops. Please make sure your child always has his/her backpack and if you get a new one- please transfer the bus tag to the new bag.
- **Curriculum Night 9/13:** The school staff is excited to welcome all parents to a Family Learning Engagement Night on September 13th; All teachers will have sessions from 6:15-6:45pm and 7:15-7:45pm. Come get information to take home that will support your child's school success. PTA General Membership Meeting 6:50-7:10pm All other specialists and special areas teachers will also be available that night to share information and answer questions. Please mark your calendar for this important parent learning night and PTA budget review and voting.
- **Carpool Process:** The carpool process at FWES provides a safe way for students to be picked up each afternoon and takes about 20-25 minutes to load the 300+ cars that come through the lane each day. Please note, however, that the first 2-4 weeks of school are when the process can take up to 40 minutes, as students are learning their new numbers and our new families and students are learning the process. Adults will NOT be allowed to check students out from the carpool holding area in the cafeteria if the child is registered as a carpooler. Please be patient and remain in line in your car until your student can be loaded safely.
- **Carpool Tags:** Students are issued NEW numbers each year- so all families will need to complete a carpool registration form to get

carpool tags at Open House. Families without 2018-19 school issued carpool tags displayed will have to pull over and sign the child out in the office after showing proper identification.

- **Walker Dismissal Reminders:** Our school has increased the number of students dismissed as walkers the last few years. This increase has put an extreme strain on available parking and on our relationship with the Kildaire Farm community. Please note that families who choose to drive to our school to meet "walkers" at the front entrance for dismissal should be respectful of the school's neighbors if you park in the neighborhood. For the safety of all pedestrians, those waiting to meet students at the front of the school will be asked to leave the area as soon as your child has been picked up so that carpool may begin to flow quickly and safely. Safety patrol will ring a triangle to notify the front porch that carpool is beginning and school staff will ask any remaining families to move down the sidewalk. In addition, families wishing to stay and play with friends will need to use the K-1 playground by the villas as the front playground is not be available during dismissal. More information is available on the school website and will be sent home the first week of school. Thank you for your cooperation!

- **Specials Scheduling Specials:** As our grade levels will vary from 4 teachers to 7, we will have some variations in our specials schedule this year that are still being configured. Final information on the rotations for each grade level will be shared through your child's teacher at the start of the year.

- **Walk to School Fridays!** Walk to school Fridays will continue into the 2018-19 school year on the 1st Friday of each month, beginning Friday, September 7th! Families meet Mr. Eller in the parking lot of Kildaire Plaza at 8:30am and enjoy a wonderful walk through the greenway to FWES. We hope you'll plan to join him that 1st week of school!

FWES School Improvement Plan 2018-2020

The School Improvement Plan (SIP) is a document that guides the work of our school community as we grow IB learners. Families are a vital part of the learning that occurs at Farmington Woods. The plan was developed last spring based on student achievement data and trends that indicate areas where our school can improve to support student success. Our plan includes an academic goal that is supported by key processes and action steps that will be implemented over the course of the next two years to support our school in achieving our goal. In addition, to monitor our progress, the plan and data related to the plan is reviewed quarterly so revisions can be made if and as needed. - ♦ All members of the School Improvement Team, staff and parents, must be voted in to represent their respective groups. Once your interest is expressed, your name will be shared with our PTA and the PTA will present you for a vote to serve at the PTA Meeting on September 13th. 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Continuing A Walk in the Woods ...

- **Before/After School Applications:** At this time, both the Before and After School programs are being filled based on the on line sign up list. Updated information will be shared as it is available on openings remaining for 2018-19.
- **Lunch Price Increase for 2018-19:** **Student Lunch price will be \$2.55.** Please make a note when sending in \$ or putting \$ on account.
- **On Line Lunch Account:** Wake County Child Nutrition Services offers all families the option to pay on student lunch accounts through www.myschoolbucks.com. Using this service allows parents to pay with credit cards and access information about the purchases your child makes each day. It also sends email alerts when your child's lunch account gets below \$5.00. The system has been upgraded from last year's mylunchmoney.com so look for the change when you log on, but your log in and password are the same.
- **Safety Patrol Sign up:** 4th and 5th grade students interested in serving on our Safety Patrol for the 18-19 school year can sign up at the Safety Patrol table during Open House. Many students are needed to assist in the mornings and afternoons with carpool. Training and scheduling of new students will take place the first few weeks of the school year.
- **Student Accident Insurance:** Accident insurance is the responsibility of each student's family. Information about student accident insurance is available on the WCPSS Website- [Student Accident Insurance](#).
- **Volunteer Registration:**
Registration is available on any WCPSS computer from July 1st-November 15th 24 hrs a day. Beginning Nov. 16th registration is only available on Mondays from 8:00am-4:00pm. Volunteers may register in the school office- registration is open now when the school is open 8:30-11:45am and 1:00-4:00pm.
- * **Returning Registered Volunteers-** Returning volunteers must reactivate his/her file through a simple process to remain on the approved volunteer list. Reactivation can be completed on a school computer. Those not reactivated by November 15th will be dropped from the approved list and will have to complete the new volunteer process to return to the list.
- * **Approved Volunteers New to FWES-** We welcome our new families. If you were an approved volunteer at another Wake County school in the 17-18 school year, you will need to re-activate your volunteer registration *as soon as possible* and make changes to your school list to include FWES- so that your clearance appears on our school approval list. This reactivation and verification of your status on the FWES list, will be required prior to volunteering in our school.
- * **New Volunteers:** All new volunteers to FWES are required to register and have a background check completed prior to volunteering. Background checks can take up to two weeks to be returned so new volunteers should register as soon as possible.
