




What is an IB Primary years Programme?


- The PYP provides an ideal foundation for children to become successful, lifelong learners by developing their:
 - social and emotional well-being
 - independence, as they take responsibility for their own learning
 - international mindedness
 - understanding of the world and their ability to function effectively within it
 - attitudes and dispositions for learning
 - ability to take mindful, appropriate and sustainable
 - student-initiated action

Units Taught through six transdisciplinary themes



Each theme is selected for their relevance to the real world. Young learners explore the commonalities of human experience by investigating these themes through a programme of inquiry.

Inquiry based instruction







Student's natural curiosity is fostered when they seek answers to their own questions.

Integration of all subject areas

Each child will participate in what we call "Specials" Art, Music, PE Chinese, Spanish. These classes connect with the inquiry units to enhance and build on the concepts.






Students take Action

Meet the Kindergarten Team






A typical day in Kinder:

- Writing (30 minutes)
- Lunch (30 minutes)

- Math (65 minutes)
- **Special** (Art, Music, PE, Spanish, Chinese) (45 minutes)
