HOW DOES IT WORK?

Each class will attend a Viewing and a Buying session. During the Viewing time, your student will create their own "Wish List" of new books they are interested in and will bring that list home. *Please be sure to circle or write out your selections on their Wish List and send it back in with your student.* Each class will come back for a Buying Time to purchase their books. If a book is a "last copy" it must be purchased, then an order is placed and it will arrive in their classroom as soon as possible.

The Book Fair will be open late for FWES families to check out all the books and gifts. It's a great opportunity to see friends and find new books that are age and level appropriate. An adult must accompany students to Family Night. (This is also a Conference Night.)

Our Book Fair has a new digital payment option! Give your student a secure, cash-free way to shop at the fair. Create a free account, preauthorize a spending limit, and have funds ready for your student. This is an easy option for parents and a new opportunity for family members to set up a gift for their grand child, niece or nephew.

When you create an eWallet, the amount you select as your student's budget will appear as a temporary hold (or pending charge) on your credit card. It will be reflected in your available balance. However, you will only be charged for what is purchased, and after the book fair ends, the hold expires, and any remaining funds will be released back to your credit card. Your student's name and the budgeted amount will already be in the Scholastic payment system when they come to purchase their books.
