Entering Kindergarten Requirements

(Summer Homework for Families)

NC Health Assessment and Immunization Record

State law requires every child entering public schools in North Carolina for the first time to receive a health assessment. The assessment must occur within 12 months prior to entering school. You should provide a completed N.C. Health Assessment Form to the school on or before the child's first day of attendance.

State law also requires these vaccinations before a student enters kindergarten and should be submitted along with the health assessment form.
