- Ask your child about an action project they might like to sponsor at school to make a difference in the world- they could talk about it on the FWES news (need at least 1 week advance notice)
- Donate a special book or classroom item to the classroom in honor of your child's birthday- consult with the teacher first, please
- Choose a healthy treat from the <u>Healthy Snacks</u> list and bring it to share with the class during your child's lunch time- *must give teacher advance notice due to allergies*- Please note in Policy 6140 that no "homemade" snacks may be served to students during the school day, they must be individually wrapped or prepared in a commercial kitchen.
