On Tuesday, 11/19, we will run a school-wide testing schedule for the NC Check-In for ELA. It is important that students arrive on time. There will be no check-outs during the testing session which will last until about 10:00am.

The NC Check-Ins 2.0 at grades 3–8 are the through-year formative component of the North Carolina Personalized Assessment Tool (NCPAT) system. The purposes are to

- provide educators, students, and stakeholders with immediate and detailed feedback on student performance on grade-level-specific content standards to inform instruction for individual student's needs; and
- provide a reliable estimate to inform a student's EOG assessment experience.
