Transition from PowerSchool to Infinite Campus

WCPSS will be launching Infinite Campus, the new Student Information System adopted by the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction, for the 2025-26 school year. Infinite Campus will replace PowerSchool and be used districtwide to house student data including grades, schedules, bus stop information. Families will receive an email from Infinite Campus to the email address we have on file for their student in late June with instructions to access their portals. *Please note that each 8th grader received their envelope with 2 family tickets on Friday from their Homeroom teacher. If a student was absent, they should see their HR teacher Monday to receive the tickets. Please ask your child for them.

*No extra tickets will be available. Lost tickets will not be replaced. School-aged children and older will need a ticket for entrance. Please know that we have no way of checking names off at the door if you do not have the physical tickets. You must have the physical ticket - please check before leaving home on the morning of the ceremony. Each guest who enters must have a ticket. Doors will open to guests at 7:35am.

*Families of 6th and 7th graders who are receiving awards received an invitation for their grade level awards program. This invitation/notification came from the Homeroom teacher through Talking Points and a paper copy was also provided to the student. Doors will open at 7:35 am for an 8:00 ceremony and 11:30am for a 12:00pm ceremony.

*Please do not plan to bring balloons, or other larger items as gifts for your child. This will take up additional space and may get in the way of other parents and family members adequately seeing their own child. These items will not be allowed in the gym.

*Please note that parents/guardians who attend the awards or promotion ceremonies will be able to check-out their child after the program if they wish to by completing a paper form that will be available in the gym at the conclusion of the ceremony.
