Students will test on their school chromebooks. All students should bring two pencils. Students who wish to use their personal calculator will turn it into their math teacher on Wednesday, October 9, 2024 to have the memory cleared by a Carnage staff member. The PSAT survey and background information will request a PowerSchool number, parent email address, student email address and home address. Wake County Public School students are expected to use their Power School number for identification. Please see the PSAT website for additional details regarding the survey and background information requested. Practice tests and testing rules are available on the College Board website. Test Day Procedures:

Students will check-in at the media center from 7:00-7:30. Please be on time. Students will not be permitted to enter the testing location after 7:30. When the test is complete, students will resume their normal schedule.
