#### Welcome to the 2025-2026 School Year

We are officially in the 25-26 school year now as all of our students have been rolled into their next grade level at Carnage in Infinite Campus. Please note that we have limited staff on campus during the summer, but please feel free to reach out to the main office or administration with questions you may have as we prepare for the school year. During the summer, the building will be open between 8:00am-2:00pm. There will be periodic summer Trojan Messengers sent with schoolwide information to assist you. Once the school year begins, the Trojan Messenger will be sent weekly - typically on Sunday.

#### **Bus Transportation**

- If your student's current status meets your needs for next school year, no action is required.
- If you need to request service or change your current transportation status, go to <u>wcpss.net/busrider</u> and fill out the form requesting transportation.
- If your student is currently assigned to transportation but will not need it next school year, please submit the decline bus form at wcpss.net/declinebus.

Important: Please only request service if you plan for your student to be a regular rider. Students who don't ride consistently will be removed from bus rosters.

### WCPSS Cell Phone Policy 2025-26

The Wake County Board of Education approved a new policy on student use of personal wireless communication devices, such as cellphones and smartwatches at their June 3 regular session meeting. Under the new policy, all student personal devices must be silenced and away during instructional time. This policy will go into effect starting with the 2025–2026 school year. This decision comes after months of gathering feedback from teachers, students, administrators, and families, as well as holding focus groups with key partners across the district. The goal is to support a healthy, focused, and safe learning environment for all students.

#### Why the policy was created:

We want to promote positive digital habits, improve student focus in classrooms, and support student well-being by reducing distractions during the school day.

#### Who this affects:

All students in elementary, middle, and high schools.

#### What the policy says:

- Elementary & Middle School Students:
  - Can bring personal devices to school.
  - Devices must be *silenced and away* between morning and afternoon bells.
  - "Put away" means out of sight and not easily accessible (ex. in a backpack or locker).
  - Exceptions are allowed for health plans, communication needs, emergencies, administrator-approved translations, safety plans, or assistive communication.
- On School Buses:
  - Students may use devices, but volume must be low and headphones used. Drivers can limit device use if safety is a concern.

#### If a student uses a device when they shouldn't:

- They will get a verbal warning first.
- If the behavior continues, the device may be taken away temporarily.
- Parents will be contacted if it becomes a pattern.



#### **Important Notes:**

- Students are responsible for keeping their own devices safe.
- The school system is not responsible for lost or stolen devices.
- Any student device may be searched if there is a reasonable suspicion about a rule being broken.
- No permission is required for a student to use a personal device to call 911.

### **Supply List Information**

We don't typically produce long supply lists for every student, but instead recommend parents get some basic school supplies for their child and wait and see if there is anything specific a particular class may need once they get started in the class. Teachers will communicate this information to students/parents at the beginning of the year. Teachers may also have "wish list" items available at Walk Your Schedule and Meet the Teachers that will allow you to support their whole classroom.

### 6th Grade Chromebooks

It is our intent to distribute the new Chromebooks to eligible 6th graders at one of our family events before school starts. If you are unable to make the event, the Chromebooks will be distributed through the homeroom teacher once school starts. More details provided later this summer.
