- Community Advisory/Student Services (ongoing) assist with clothing/food drives, work with community programs to enhance students' ability to succeed at school

- Cultural Arts (ongoing) coordinate artist-in-residence, author visits, grant writing
- Health & Safety (ongoing) coordinate Healthy Hunter week (spring), morning activity clubs

Operations Committee

- Building & Grounds (ongoing) implement courtyard, landscape, and garden improvements
