

Join the Hunter Chess Club!

Whether your child is just learning to play chess, enjoyed a Hunter chess elective, or is an experienced tournament player, the Hunter Chess Club is a great way to have fun, learn, and play lots of chess! Playing chess can improve academic skills such as analysis, creativity, and reasoning and can enhance life skills such as perseverance, resilience, and assertiveness. Our chess club is sponsored by the Hunter PTA, led by a team of enthusiastic parent volunteers, and is open to all Hunter students.



When and where: We meet on Wednesday afternoons at Hunter from 3:45–5:00 p.m. during the school year.

What we do: Each week we learn new chess skills and practice them by playing chess. We use ChessKid.com to practice and play each other between meetings. Our club plays as a team in local US Chess Federation (USCF) tournaments including the NC Chess Championship (March 11-12, 2017, in Raleigh). We also organize our own tournaments.

Cost: We will collect an activity fee of \$30 per student, which will provide each student with a 1-year USCF membership, a 1-year ChessKid Gold subscription, and a chess scorebook. Financial aid is available.

Getting involved: Volunteering at chess club is a great way to see what your child is learning and requires no chess experience. Sign-ups are available throughout the year. Parent/guardian most likely to volunteer _____
