What is our theme?

GIFTED AND TALENTED

The GT Program offers an extensive elective menu for exploration of interests, acceleration, and rich, in-depth study in all subject areas to enhance Common Core and Essential Standards. Parents and students select courses from a diverse menu of elective offerings each quarter. For example, a child who is gifted in math may be challenged in an academically gifted math elective or a child who is artistic has opportunities to take dance or music electives. World Language instruction and expanded visual and performing arts opportunities are available K-12 with extensive AP and IB course offerings in high school.

AG BASICS (K-8)

Students in the AG (Academically Gifted) Basics Program are grouped with other AG identified students for Language Arts or Math according to their individual qualifications. Enloe Magnet High provides a continuation of this program through advanced courses and electives. This program is offered at four schools in conjunction with the GT magnet theme.



What if my child is Academically Gifted?

Your child will receive Academically Gifted services in the area in which they are identified (math, language arts, both).

How many teacher teams are at each grade level?

- Each grade level has two teams, which consist of 6-7 teachers per team.
- Each grade level is assigned a guidance counselor and assistant principal

What does a typical day look like?

Students are enrolled in four core subject classes (Language Arts, Math, Social Studies, and Science) and three electives.

What electives are offered?

- Electives are based on the core subjects.
