# Child Care Options this Summer

## Extension of Virtual Academy (VA) Application Window

- The School Board is Meeting tomorrow, July 21, to consider possibly moving to Plan C. The Virtual Academy application window will be extended beyond today, 7/20. The ending date of this new extension hasn't been set. Families can wait to hear the School Board's decision about whether we will move to Plan C before completing the virtual Academy application, if desired.
- Please note, after the first semester you can potentially switch from VA to plan B (if Plan B is an Option). You could also request a switch from Plan B To VA. Further, you could request to stay in VA for the whole year if you had originally signed up for the first semester only. The goal at Washington would be to facilitate these moves if possible. However, any moves from your original plan choice is contingent on available space and will have to be assessed by the principal at that time.

# SSA (Single Subject Acceleration)
