Fine Motor Skills:

Before entering kindergarten your child should be able to:

- Grip a pencil
- Use scissors appropriately
- Engage in activities that cross the body's midline

Social Skills:

Your child should be able to:

- Recognize and respond to name
- Communicate with adults and children
- Listen and follow directions
- Take turns and share
- Effectively communicate their wants and needs
- Be responsible for his or her own belongings
- Listen to others without interrupting
- Follow single step directions

Math:

Your child should be able to:

- Demonstrate basic knowledge of numbers 1-10
- Identify colors and basic shapes
- Express an interest in exploring patterns

Literacy:

Your child should be able to:

- Demonstrate basic knowledge of letters and sounds
- Recognize and write name
- Actively engage when listening to a story
- Show an interest in books

Health and Wellness:

Your child should independently be able to:

- Use the restroom and take care of all toileting needs
- Properly use buttons and zippers on clothing

Before starting kindergarten your child needs to have:

- A completed kindergarten health assessment
- Up to date immunization records
