First Day

- Students should report directly to their 1st period class when the 6:55am bell rings. First period begins at 7:25 AM.
- Please check PowerSchool for the most up-to-date schedule and room numbers on Monday.
- If a student cannot get on PowerSchool, they can see a counselor in the Auditorium before school starts to get their schedule.
- School starts promptly at 7:25am – all students should be in their 1st period class at that time. Dismissal for the day is at 2:18pm.

- Students that wish to purchase breakfast in the cafeteria can do that and then take it to their 1st period class to eat. We don't have student lunch once the 6:55 bell rings.

Carpool

-Carpool uses the entrance off McCrimmon Parkway that is closest to Hwy 55 (across from the new housing development entrance). The 1 lane out. The exterior entrance lane will take you to the drop off point near the modular buildings. The interior entrance lane will take you to the drop off point near the main office. You can use either one. Please pull as far up as you can but your kids can start getting out as soon as they are in the drop off zone to expedite the process.

Transportation

-Students can ask transportation questions during lunch. We will direct them where to go. There office is next to the cafeteria.

After School Activities

-Students must be in direct supervision of a staff member after the 2:18pm bell. This means they should report directly to their after-school activity. Students cannot stay after if they are not in a supervised activity.
