Panther Creek High School Remote Learning Schedule – starting April 13, 2020

On April 13th, we will start moving forward with new, remote learning in our courses. Students may begin getting preview information by April 1st. Here is some information to help support you:

- We recognize that during this time, each family may have varying needs when it comes to daily routines. If you would like to provide a daily, structured routine for your child that aligns more with a typical school day, we have provided you a sample schedule that you may choose to use.
 - o Please note that students do have flexibility to work as needed based on parameters and due dates assigned by their teachers.
- We have also outlined the specific, protected class period times where teachers may choose to
 provide synchronous learning with each of their classes. This will allow you to easily identify
 when students may be asked to participate at a specific time of the day. Teachers will provide
 more direction about what this will look like for their class weekly.
- Each teacher will also be holding "office hours" for at least one hour per day where they can interact with students needing additional support, clarification or feedback regarding their learning.
- The expectation is that students have about 5 hours of course engagement per week per course.
 - o This may look different for different courses based on content, needs of students, etc. While some of the instruction may be at specific times, there will also be asynchronous learning (students working at their own pace). Please make sure that students are adhering to the direction provided weekly by their teacher including the deadlines for tasks to be completed.
- Teachers will provide weekly course pacing to students through their established electronic platform (ex: Canvas or Google Classroom).
- Students are encouraged to reach out directly to teachers if they have questions, need additional support or clarification, or need to schedule time for more specific assistance regarding their learning.
- Parents may contact teachers through email.
- Live learning sessions are for student participation only.
- Students should always use their WakeID log-in and WCPSS student email for communication.
