

## REGISTER FOR ON-CAMPUS COVID-19 TESTING

In partnership with MAKO Medical, we are now offering free, weekly pooled COVID-19 testing on-campus for PCHS students and staff. **Please note: This is not a Walk-In Testing site.** Starting Tuesday February 1<sup>st</sup>, testing will be conducted **every Tuesday during Smart Lunch in Mod 3, Room 304 from 10:30 – 11:30 am.** Participation in the program is voluntary. Here's how it works:

- Once you are registered, you are committing to attend the weekly testing **every Tuesday** during Smart Lunch. Depending on how many are being tested that day will determine how long it will take to go through the testing process. You will NOT receive a pass to leave class, you must go during your lunch break. Any no-shows will be contacted by MAKO not PCHS staff.
- Trained MAKO Medical staff quickly and gently swab students' and staff members noses. They place multiple swabs in a single tube, which are then tested as a single sample. If a positive test is received, everyone in the "pool" will return to school the next day to take another test to identify the person who tested positive for COVID-19. - The intent of this program is to identify asymptomatic positive cases. If you are experiencing symptoms, you should stay home and get tested at a different location and follow the [WCPSS When to Return guidelines](#).
