WALKER AGREEMENT FORM

Oak Grove Elementary School takes our students safety seriously. The Wake County Public School System has guidelines that each school must adhere to for the safety of students wanting to walk or bike to and from school. With that said we are implementing those guidelines into our walking approval for the 2022-2023 school year. We ask that students and Parents/Guardians who walk or ride a bike to and from school follow these procedures:

- 1. Parents of all students who walk to and from school will need to complete this form and indicate if the student:
 - a. Has permission to leave our campus on his/her own (YELLOW TAG)
 - b. Is allowed to walk with an older sibling (ORANGE TAG)
 - c. Is only allowed to leave our campus with an approved adult (RED TAG)
- 2. Students will receive a color-coded walkers pass to serve as a visual indicator to our staff for which children can leave campus on their own and which one requires an adult chaperone. The walker passes should always be attached to the student's book bag. If they have lost it, please replace it by going to the office.
 - a. If you are allowing a younger sibling to walk home with an older sibling, you agree your child is capable to be responsible for his/her younger siblings. _____ Int.
- 3. When your child walks to school in the morning, he/she must enter through the front office entrance. When your child leaves school as a walker at 3:45, he /she will exit the building through the front office entrance.
- 4. By signing this form Student and parent/guardian agree to all the following:
 - a. I understand that WCPSS requires student's cross Penny Road with the crossing guard at the approved crosswalk even if an adult is with them.
 - b. I understand that WCPSS, requires a sidewalk while walking on Penny Road. If there is not a sidewalk to your neighborhood Oak Grove elementary will not be able to approve your request even if you live with in the radius of the school.
 - c. I understand that Oak Grove elementary has approved streets for walkers and bikers. If the student does not live on the approved street, then Oak Grove elm. will not be able to approve your request.
- 5. When your child needs to be picked up by a car you will be <u>required</u> to follow the carpool protocol.
 - a. If you have a carpool number, then proceed in the carpool lane and follow carpool rules.
 - b. If you do not have a carpool number, you will need to park your vehicle and walk to the front door to sign them out at the office.
 - c. For safety reasons and respect to those that might have issues with pets, please DO NOT bring pets of any kind on the school property.
