- FINISHED POSTER MUST MEASURE 16 x 22 DO NOT MATTE The Town of Cary staff will matte and frame for judging purposes (You will have to cut down a standard poster).
- Use any medium MUST NOT BE 3 DIMENSIONAL
- Posters MUST incorporate the theme "Send a Message Stay Drug Free" Each Poster is to be made by one person; no group projects accepted.
- All posters must have the following information on the back of the poster for judging purposes:
  - STUDENT NAME
    - SCHOOL NAME AND PHONE #

- GRADE
- STUDENT HOME PHONE #
- TEACHER NAME

- Five posters from each school will be accepted and forwarded to the Town of Carv for judging. Town of Cary judges will choose a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winner from each school and an overall grand prize winner. Judges consist of 2 council members, 1 member of Cary Teen Council, 1 Cultural Arts Representative, and 1 member of the Cary Police Department.
