
Transcripts

Follow these steps to get your transcripts sent to your college/university:

- O If you are attending a college/university in North Carolina, use the transcript manager on <u>www.cfnc.org</u>. <u>AND</u> complete the Senior Intention Survey using your Wake ID.
 *You must select- this is your final transcript
- O If you are attending a college/university outside of North Carolina, you need to request that by going to <u>www.wcpss.net/transcripts</u> <u>AND</u> completing the Senior Intention Survey using your Wake ID.

Important Note: All transcripts will be sent by June 28, 2019. It is likely that you will get an automated email from your admissions office requesting the final transcript. **Do not worry!** If you have followed the directions above, it will be or has already been delivered

All WCPSS high schools are required to report graduating seniors' future plans. Please fill out the Senior Intention Survey one time only using your Wake ID. This form must be completed by all graduates regardless of your post-graduation plans.

Schedule for June 3rd:

• <u>6:45- 8:00</u>: Senior Night Program; family and friends welcome to attend. Dress code underneath the gown (and shoes) is the same as on graduation day.

Graduation Practice

- Graduation practice will be held at the Raleigh Convention Center in downtown Raleigh on Thursday, June 6th from 1-3 pm. Since we have a limited amount of time for practice, seniors should plan to arrive no later than 12:30 at Entrance C.
- Practice is mandatory. If you choose not to attend practice, you will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony unless you have e-mailed Ms. Collins (kacollins@wcpss.net), and she emails you back giving permission.
- Dress code for practice is casual- shorts, t-shirts, flip flops, etc.
- Women: you may want to wear/bring your graduation shoes to the practice.
- Each senior is responsible for his/her own transportation. There is a parking deck across from the Convention Center; you will have to pay for parking.
- 7 graduation tickets will be distributed at practice to students that have reconciled all fines/debts/consequences owed to GHHS. If you do not receive your tickets, we will give you documentation of what needs to be reconciled.
- Parents and/or friends cannot pick up tickets.
- The main office will not have any extra tickets.
- Graduation requirements will be reviewed for each senior and his/her status will be decided by 11:00 a.m. on June 11th. Any senior who fails to meet (or who thinks they might not have met) the academic requirements for graduation may contact their counselor on June 6th to determine their status. School counselors will make every attempt to contact the parent and the student, but it remains the responsibility of the student and/or the parent to contact the counselor from 9-11 on June 11th.

Graduation

- Graduation is at the Raleigh Convention Center on Friday, June 14th 2019 at 4:00.
- Seniors must arrive **<u>BY</u>** 3:00 p.m. and be appropriately attired.
- Dress code: Tennis shoes or flip flops are not allowed. <u>Men</u>: dress shirt, tie, and dress pants. <u>Women</u>: dress or skirt and blouse or dress pants and blouse. Be careful about the height of your heels; you will be walking up stairs and across a temporary stage.
- If a senior is discovered to have sold his/her graduation tickets, he/she will be prohibited from participating in the graduation ceremony.
- In order to participate in graduation, seniors will need to reconcile any fines/debts/consequences owed to GHHS.
- You will not walk if you are late to graduation or if you are dressed inappropriately.
- If you behave inappropriately while in the audience or as you walk across the stage, your diploma will be held.
- If you choose **NOT** to walk in graduation, please email Ms. Collins (kacollins@wcpss.net) by May 31st.
- Admission to graduation is by ticket only. No one will be admitted without a ticket (WCPSS teacher badges will allow a guest in without a ticket.)
- Remember that participating in graduation is a privilege. Behavior must be above standard for the remainder of the school year. Your participation in graduation is contingent on your good behavior from now until June 14th.
