EXAM NOTES

*The exam schedule is subject to change

- Students with 3 EOCs will take the Math 3 EOC on January 14th or 15th as advised by the Testing Coordinator.
- Students are expected to take exams at the scheduled times, must be present at the beginning of the exam period to take the exam and must remain for the entire exam period to receive credit for the exam.
- If absent, submit a parent note to the Attendance Office upon return to school. The student is responsible for working with the teacher to schedule the make-up exam date for teacher made and CTE exams. The Testing Coordinator will schedule the make-up EOC & NCFE exams. All make-up state exams are given on computers.
- Students who do not have an EOC or make-up exam do not report to school January 16th. 18th.
- All final exams will count as 20% of the final grade, unless advised otherwise by the teacher.
- According to North Carolina testing policy, students are not allowed to bring electronic devices (other than
 approved calculators) into the testing room at any time during state testing, including breaks. A student
 dismissed for a violation of the electronic device policy must take the missed exam on January 18th. Per WCPSS
 policy, the student is subject to disciplinary action by school administration.
- Buses will run on a regular schedule during exams. Students may not return to a class after they have taken the final exam. Under no circumstances can students be on other school campuses on exam days.
- The State Testing and Accountability Program includes North Carolina Final Exams (NCFE), End of Course (EOC) exams, and post assessments for CTE courses. Per Board Policy, seniors are not eligible for exemption from exams for courses with state testing requirements.
