Enter Campus

- Please enter campus via the carpool entrance.
 - **Note:** this is a change from our original communication.
- Follow the signs around toward the front circle.
- The main entrance drive will be closed to traffic.



Graduate Drop-Off

- Graduates will be dropped off at the designated location and graduate guests will proceed to vehicle staging area
- Graduate guests are **limited to 2 vehicles**





Number of Vehicles

- We ask that you limit your family's number of vehicles to 2.
 - This allows us to stay in compliance with COVID 19 regulations.
 - This also follows the recommendations of the NC Dept of Instruction.

Safety

- All passengers (family members and friends) must remain in their vehicles to ensure compliance with COVID19 safety regulations.
- Only graduates will be allowed to exit vehicles.



Safety

- Once they are in the circle, graduates will line up **4 at a time** on marks indicated on the sidewalk to maintain social distancing.
- Please follow guidance from staff members.

Receiving Diploma Cover

- Step 1: Graduates will step on to the stage.
 - Staff will be directing.
- Step 2: Graduates will step in front of the table.
- Step 3: Graduates will pick up their diploma cover.

Receiving Diploma Cover

- Step 5: Graduates will wait 3 seconds for their photo to be taken.
- Step 6: Graduates will step down the center of the stage.

Receiving Diploma Cover

- Step 7: Graduates will walk to the designated area to receive their diploma to place inside their diploma cover.
 - Family vehicle(s) will pull forward to make room for next graduate and family.
- Step 8: Graduates will enter their vehicles.
 - Family vehicle(s) will pull away.



Photography

- Strawbridge will be taking professional photographs.
- They will make their information available.
- The stage will be very close to the curb-your family will be able to take photos and videos from your vehicle.





Attire

- We are recommending that students wear their full graduation regalia, including cap, gown, stole and national honor cords.
- The stage is 3 feet high with steps. Please be careful about shoes with heels.
