

- <u>3:30-4:30pm</u>: Seniors with last names Sia-Z




Enter Campus

- Please enter campus via the carpool entrance.

- Follow the signs around toward the front circle.
- The main entrance drive will be closed to traffic.



Graduate Drop-Off

- Graduates will be dropped off at the designated location and graduate guests will proceed to vehicle staging area
- Graduate guests are limited to 2 vehicles




Number of Vehicles

• We ask that you limit your family's number of vehicles to 2.

Safety

Safety

- Once they are in the circle, graduates will line up <u>4 at a time</u> on marks indicated on the sidewalk to maintain social distancing.

Receiving Diploma Cover

- <u>Step 1</u>: Graduates will step on to the stage.
 Staff will be directing.
- <u>Step 2</u>: Graduates will step in front of the table.
- <u>Step 3</u>: Graduates will pick up their diploma cover.





Receiving Diploma Cover

<u>Step 4:</u> Graduates will turn to face their families.



Receiving Diploma Cover

- <u>Step 5</u>: Graduates will wait 3 seconds for their photo to be taken.
- <u>Step 6</u>: Graduates will step down the center of the stage.

Receiving Diploma Cover

- <u>Step 7</u>: Graduates will walk to the designated area to receive their diploma to place inside their diploma cover.
 - Family vehicle(s) will pull forward to make room for next graduate and family.
- <u>Step 8</u>: Graduates will enter their vehicles.
 - Family vehicle(s) will pull away.





Photography

- Strawbridge will be taking professional photographs.
- They will make their information available.
- The stage will be very close to the curb-your family will be able to take photos and videos from your vehicle.





Attire

• We are recommending that students wear their full graduation regalia, including cap, gown, stole and national honor cords.

• The <u>stage is 3 feet high</u> <u>with steps</u>. Please be careful about shoes with heels.
