Grade Reports:

The grade earned in GradPoint Credit Recovery Summer School will be Pass/Fail and will NOT count toward the GPA but will appear on the transcript. All previous grades remain on the transcript and are calculated in the GPA.

Notification of Summer School grades will be emailed to students/parents at the end of the Summer School session. This takes the place of an official report card. Parents need to monitor progress daily.

Summer School Structure

Students are admitted in the following priority order:

1. Seniors needing to graduate (2022)
2. Juniors needing to be promoted and graduate (2023)
3. Sophomores needing a class to be promoted
4. Freshmen needing a class to be promoted

Green Hope HS will use the GradPoint curriculum placement and course content with recommended supplemental materials.
