

04/15/2020 - UPDATED INFORMATION ON WAKE TECH'S CAREER AND COLLEGE PROMISE (CCP) APPLICATION PROCESS

VIRTUAL MANDATORY CAREER AND COLLEGE PROMISE INFORMATION SESSION

In lieu of an in-person information session

Students interested in participating in the **Career and College Program at Wake Tech**, please note that Wake Tech has developed an online version of the **Mandatory Information Session**. Students who attended an in-person information session this semester are not required to attend both. Students will be able to complete the Mandatory Information Session online through Wake Tech's CCP website (<https://www.waketech.edu/admissions-aid/career-and-college-promise/info-session>). For students to obtain credit for attendance at the mandatory online session the student must do the following:

- Watch the ENTIRE video from Wake Tech
- Sign-In, and
- Complete the survey

Failure to do all three steps above may result in not receiving the Wake Tech CCP application materials.

The online version will assist students as our community deals with the current COVID 19 situation. Regarding future in-person sessions, Wake Tech is currently waiting to see how the COVID 19 situation resolves.

ONLINE APPLICATION TO WAKE TECH CCP

After attending the mandatory online (or in-person) information session, Wake Tech will provide an **online application and EV (high school approval) form**. As of 04/15/20, Wake Tech has not started sending these yet, but students who attended the in-person session this semester, and now students who successfully attend the online version will receive the online application and EV form once Wake Tech has them ready to send out.

As a part of the process of applying to the CCP Program at Wake Tech, students will be required to request approval to attend CCP from their high school via the "EV Form" (provided electronically by Wake Tech). To request approval on the EV form, students must **fully fill out the form** (all fields required) and list a parent's email address and a school approval email. **The GHHS school approval email address is ghhsccp@wcpss.net**. Please choose this email when prompted during the EV submittal process (do not send questions to the ghhsccp@wcpss.net, if you have questions about the GHHS approval, email Ms. Barone at cbarone@wcpss.net). If you are a 9th and 10th grader, your request for approval will be reviewed by Dr. Hedrick. If you are a 10-11th grader, your request for approval will be reviewed by Ms. Barone.

TRANSCRIPTS

An unofficial transcript is required by WTCC for the CCP application. While we work virtually, unofficial transcripts cannot be sent to students by counselors or Ms. Barone. Students must apply for an unofficial transcript through Scriborder:
