<p>1) Learners should be able to use the bathroom and wash their hands independently. Practice proper handwashing techniques at home.</p> <p>2) Learners should be able to dress themselves including buttoning/zippering coats and pants. Learners should practice wearing a mask and building mask stamina.</p> <p>3) Learners should be able to open lunch containers and eat independently. Learners should be able to pack and unpack their own backpacks.</p>	<p>1) Write your first name Learners should be able to Write their first name starting with a capital letter followed by lowercase letters.</p> <p>2) Counting to 10 Learners should practice rote counting to 10 and counting sets of objects to 10.</p> <p>Try this website to practice these skills!</p>

<p><u>Reading at home</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Create a reading routine. In kindergarten, children will grow to read/look at books for 20 minutes a day.● Look at the pictures together and talk about what you see.● Practice talking about the book after you've finished reading.	<p><u>Math at home</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Practice sorting and counting during play with toys.● Notice colors and shapes in the world around you.● Practice counting steps as you walk, or practice rote counting while in the car.
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
