The **APPLICATION** process!

The Early College application window opens October 15, 2020 and closes December 14, 2020 (for seats in 2021 - 2022).

- ❑ Current WCPSS students may submit applications beginning October 15th.
- ❑ If you are not already enrolled, you need to enroll in your base school for your address. [Find your base school.](#)
- ❑ You can start your enrollment forms online at wcpss.net/enroll
- ❑ Once enrolled, create your parent account at earlycolleges.wcpss.net/apply. You must have an active student ID number.
- ❑ You will complete your application in the parent account. You may apply to any school to which you are eligible
- ❑ You will be notified of results mid-February 2021. [View Early College selection priorities.](#)
- ❑ If you are selected, you will be automatically assigned to that school. If you are not selected, you will be placed in the waiting list, known as an applicant pool, for your first-choice school only.

The **APPLICATION** process!

What's included in the application?

- ❑ Three (3) recommendations: (1) ELA teacher, (2) Math teacher, (3) Counselor or administrator
- ❑ Student essay 250 maximum word count for middle school applicants, and 500 maximum word count for high applicants
- ❑ Academic and attendance history for current and previous two years.
