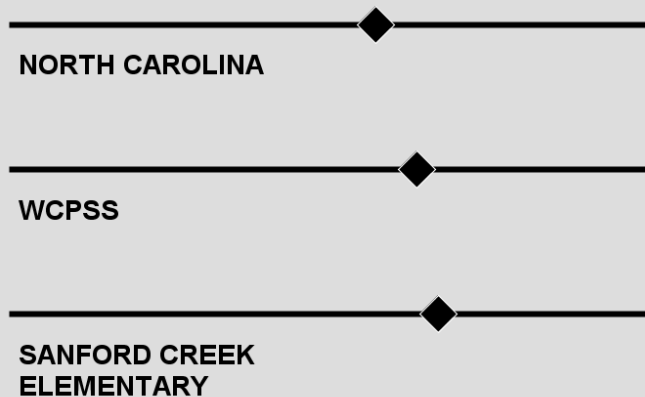

Students At Grade Level

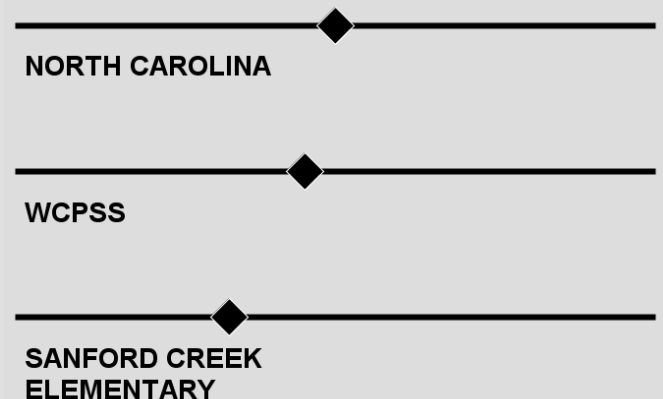
