Parents, this is very important announcement regarding Election Day. Holly Springs Elementary is a polling location for this year's election. Please note that on November 8th we will be on a two hour delay schedule. Students cannot arrive on campus earlier than 10:50a.m. The school day will be from 11:20a.m. until 3:50 p.m. The Before and After School Program will run on a normal schedule. Breakfast will only be served for before school care students. The school will have an altered schedule that day with students eating lunch in their classrooms and we will have indoor recess. Officer Tew and other officers from the Holly Springs Police Department will be on campus directing traffic and assisting with voting crowds. We will be altering carpool traffic to two lanes this day only. One lane will be for drop-off/pick-up and another for voting. As you enter the school, the right lane will be for carpool traffic and the left lane will be for funneling voter traffic into the front parking lot. Please be patient with carpool. There will be no before and after-school meetings and clubs and we are limiting visitors to the school by not offering lunch visitation times or classroom volunteers on this day. This is for the safety of our students and thank you for your patience and understanding as we work to ensure our students' instructional day are impacted as little as possible by the voters on our campus.
