| Meeting Minutes/Quarter 2 Review | |

The meeting was called to order by our chair, Charlene Gatewood, at 3:20 p.m. Our special assistant, Jill Herbst, joined us for this month's meeting.

Academic Goal Update - Start of the school year students are identified by their EOG and end of year i-Ready Diagnostic score. To align with our SIP plan we specifically targeted students achieving 3 and 4's. With grade level admin, the intervention coordinator, and teacher input intervention groups are formed. Groups meet 1 x per week focusing on their common weakness.

Mid-year we meet again, specifically after quarter 2 ends and the winter i-Ready has been administered. We use this data to identify which students will continue, stop, or join the intervention groups.

A1.07 Indicator Update - A significant number of faculty still have not submitted the survey regarding values. The SIT will decide whether to send out the same survey, an abbreviated one or start the process again. Jill, our special assistant, strongly suggested we use the 10 values already created on the wise ways sheets since they are applicable to any classroom.
