Latest Driver Education Information for Green Hope Students

Classroom Sessions: In order for students to be considered for a Driver Education class, a registration form must be submitted to Coach Bunn. Per WCPSS/Jordan Driving School policy, students are placed into classes according to age, not the date the registration form is submitted (the oldest 35 students are placed into each class). Many students do not take Driver Education until they are already 15, 16 or 17 years old so there is always a waiting list for the classroom- many students will not get into a class prior to their 15th birthday.

Registration Periods:

- September to December Classes-- Registration forms will be accepted from August 15th through Nov. 1st
- January to May Classes—Registration forms will be accepted from Nov. 1st through March 1st
- Summer Driver Ed (June to August Classes)-- Registration forms will be accepted during the month of April. (In order to be considered for a summer class, a summer registration form must be submitted). For any summer classes not filled during the April registration period- registration forms will be accepted on a 1st come 1st serve basis. Summer registration forms and class schedules should be available at www.jordandriving.com at the end of March. During the summer, students can enroll in a Driver Education class at any convenient Wake County High School.

Behind-the-wheel (BTW) update: There is currently a waiting period of approximately 16 weeks between the completion of the class and beginning the driving phase. Placement in BTW is made based on when the class is completed and oldest to youngest within each class When contacted by the driver to schedule, please be sure to make note of his/her name, contact information, and schedule for driving.
