Beginning Friday, January 12th, we will begin administering End-Of-Course (EOCs) Exams. Beginning Wednesday, January 17th, we will begin administering NCFEs and CTE Post Assessments. Please remember that EOCs, NCFEs, and CTE Post Assessments are State-mandated Exams and all students must take these Exams. There are no Senior Exam Exemptions for those Exams. Final Exams count 20% of a student's final grade. Please also remember that if a student does not have a Final Exam scheduled for that day, he/she does not need to be on campus.

We are working on several additions to the Spring Semester Master Schedule. Due to the increase in the number of students enrolled at Athens Drive Magnet High School, we are adding several new staff members at the Semester and creating new classes. In order to balance class sizes and fill our new classes, Counselors are currently working on changing some of our student schedules. Please be aware that some student's schedule may change slightly due to the additions of new class sections. Because we are making changes, we will add a Schedule Change Request Period for students to request a schedule change. A request for schedule change(s) will be available for students that meet the following criteria:

- 3. Do not have a full schedule of 4 classes.
- 4. Want to move up/drop down a level in a core class (Must have signed Release form if dropping Honors/AP course).

5. Course needed for promotion and/or Graduation

Request for Schedule Change forms will be available on Thursday, January 4, 2018 in the Student Services office. All forms must be completed and returned to the Student Services office by 2:30 p.m. on Wednesday, January 10th. This is a firm deadline and no forms will be accepted after this time. I am excited to be able to add new staff, create new classes, and reduce class sizes for several of our core instructional classes.

Once Final Exams begin, Student Services will not be able to sign driver's eligibility forms until all grades are final for the First Semester. Driver's eligibility forms will not be signed from Tuesday, January 9th through Thursday, February 1st to ensure that all grades are stored/finalized so that we can verify that students have met the educational requirement for DMV. We will resume signing DMV forms on Friday, February 2nd.

Even though we will be out of school over the Holidays, many of our teams will still be competing in tournaments. We are hosting the WRAL Wrestling Tournament and a Junior Varsity Basketball tournament over the Holiday break.
