Please remember that our Final Exams continue all of next week. We have the Biology End-Of-Course (EOC) Exam and English II, English III, and Math I Make-Up Exams on Tuesday, January 16th. First and Second Period North Carolina Final Exams (NCFEs), CTE Post Assessments, and Teacher-Made Final Exams will be given on Wednesday, January 17th. On Thursday, January 18th, we will be administering Third and Fourth Period NCFEs, CTE Post Assessments, and Teacher-Made Final Exams. Friday, January 19th is a Make-Up Exam Day and only students who still need to take an Exam should come to school. Please remember that EOCs, NCFEs, and CTE Post Assessments are State-mandated Exams and all students must take these Exams. There are no Senior Exam Exemptions for those Exams. Final Exams count 20% of a students' final grade. Please also remember that if a student does not have a Final Exam scheduled for that day, he/she should not be on campus.

Please also remember that students are not allowed to check out before the end of any Testing session. Each year it seems that students will communicate with parents to come and pick them up because they are done with their Final Exam. However, no student can be released from their Testing Room until the Final Exam Period is over. Please prearrange to meet with your student after the Final Exam Period is over if a student is leaving campus. On the Athens Drive website (www.wcpss.net/athensdrivehs) we have posted the Permission form for students to be released after their Exam Period.

The Wake County Public School System has announced make-up days for the school days we missed last week. Monday, January 22nd and Monday, February 19th are now school days for students. Monday, January 22nd is now the first day of the Second Semester. Please be sure to make these changes on your calendar.
