Our Counselors will be conducting Sophomore Registration Conferences starting Monday, March 18^{th} . Please encourage your student to attend their conferences because counselors will be assisting each student with course registration for the 2019-2020 school year as well as providing information to assist students with preparing for their Junior year. Counselors are still meeting with Ninth Grade students individually to assist students with course registration for them as well.

Our school has been selected to participate in the CWRA+ assessment. The CWRA+ is a required part of Wake County Public School System's (WCPSS) broader effort to develop a balanced assessment system as outlined by our Strategic Plan. This test measures concepts, like Critical Thinking, which we are not able to measure using only End-Of-Course and North Carolina Final Exams. It also provides our Superintendent with valuable data on how we are doing as a School and District. This assessment lasts approximately 90 minutes. Last week we gave information to approximately 200 Juniors who were randomly selected to take this assessment. We will be giving the CWRA+ in small groups on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of next week to those students.

Please remember that the Third Quarter ends on Tuesday, March 26th and the Fourth Quarter begins the next day, on Wednesday, March 27th. I know this has been a long stretch of classes without breaks, and I just want to ask parents to help remind our students, including our Seniors, to stay focused on finishing the Third Quarter strong and building for a great ending to the 2018 – 2019 school year. Please remember that Third Quarter Report Cards will go home on Friday, April 5th.

The Athens Drive Magnet High School Food Pantry is now open! Our Food Pantry is a collaborative effort with the Food Bank of North Carolina to serve Athens Drive Magnet High School, A.B. Combs Elementary School, Dillard Drive Middle School, and Centennial Middle School students and their families.
