It is wonderful to see how our students are able to tap into so many different areas of interest to support their growth and help them reach their full potential. Congratulations to the Athens Drive Theatre Program! They had a truly awesome night at the annual Triangle Rising Stars awards show in Durham on Thursday, May 16th. Our very own Vishal Kasula, Anna Vitipil, and William Wakeford performed with the other 20 finalists in the Best Actor/Actress categories. Vishy was voted the "Triangle Shining Star," an award selected by the Top 20 finalists for the student who exhibits positive behavior and an enthusiastic spirit in all Triangle Rising Stars related activities! In addition, "All Shook Up" won the Marchael Bayne's Best Musical Award! This is the first year that Athens Drive has been nominated for *both* Best Ensemble and Best Musical and their first major award as a Theatre Department! I would like to highlight some of our athletic achievements that were celebrated at our Annual Sports Awards program on Wednesday night. With regards to sportsmanship, not a single student athlete was ejected from a contest during the Spring athletic season. The programs that were ejection free this year were: Men's Soccer, Gymnastics, Cross Country, Women's Golf, Women's Basketball, Wrestling, Cheerleading, Women's Tennis, Volleyball, Women's Lacrosse, Women's Soccer, Baseball, Softball, Men's Swimming, Women's Swimming, Spring Track and Field, Men's Tennis, Men's Golf, Stunt, and Winter Track and Field. With regards to accomplishments in all our sports, we had a great year. In the Fall, the Men's Soccer team went to the Elite 8 in the State Playoffs, Will Burke represented the Cross Country team at the State Meet, the Women's Golf team took multiple players to the State Match, and the Gymnastics team finished in 4th place in the State in the large school division. In the Winter season, the Men's Basketball team won a Conference Title for the first time since 1997 and hosted a first round State Playoff game, the Men's Swimming team finished runner-up in the Eastern Regional Meet and finished in 4th place in the State Meet, Shylik Scriven was the first Athens Drive Wrestler to qualify for the State Final Match since 2001, the Indoor Track and Field team sent numerous athletes to the State Meet, the Cheerleaders finished in 4th place in the Wake County Championships, and the Women's Basketball team made it to the Second Round of the State Playoffs. In the Spring season the Men's Lacrosse team had an outstanding season finishing 2nd in the Conference and hosting a First Round State Playoff game, the Women's Soccer team qualified for the State Playoffs and finished 3rd in the Conference, the Men's Golf Team sent Ashwath Kapilavai to the State Match, Men's Tennis had their highest Conference finish in almost 10 years, and the Track team will again send numerous athletes to the State Meet. We also had record crowds at events throughout the year, as our students and families supported our JAGS in unprecedented ways. I want to thank all our student athletes, coaches, trainers, JAG Club, and all our families for your support of Athens Drive athletics throughout the year!

Also, I want to offer my congratulations to the Orchestra for earning top scores and an overall Superior rating at Music in the Parks Festival!
