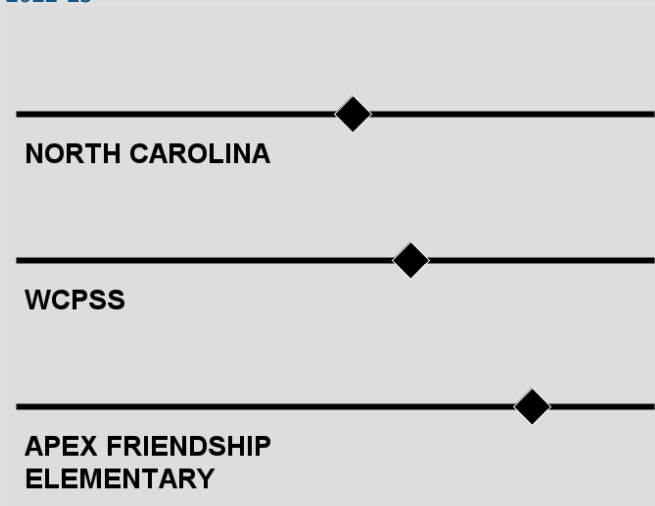

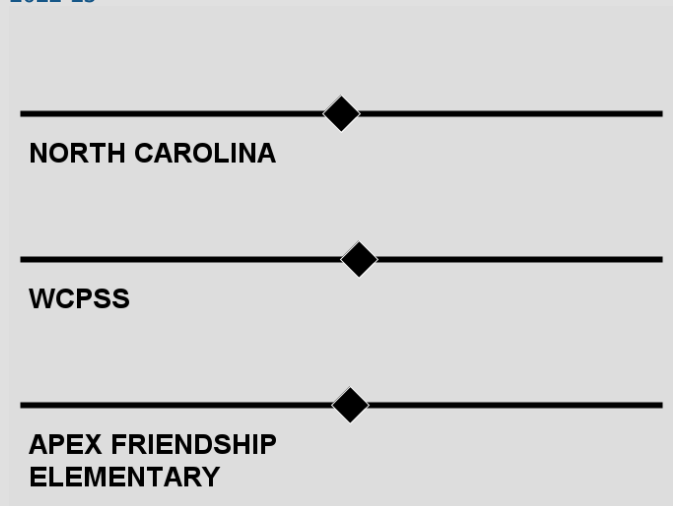
HOW WE COMPARE
