

Middle Creek High School NHS Selection Process

Our NHS chapter evaluates students on the 4 main pillars of NHS:

- Scholarship
- Service
- Leadership
- Character
- 1. After the 1st 20 days of school, co-advisors are given a list of 11th & 12th students with a qualifying GPA for our chapter of NHS. MCHS has established a cumulative weighted 3.8 GPA as the minimum requirement.
- 2. Those students are invited to complete a candidate packet.
- 3. The NHS Faculty Council reviews all packets—assessing the remaining 3 areas:
 - a. Significant evidence of Leadership
 - b. Significant evidence of Service
 - c. Evidence of Strong Character
- 4. All candidates are then notified as to whether or not they met the criteria in order to be inducted into our chapter of NHS.
- 5. Induction ceremony is held for new inductees.
