



## Middle Creek High School NHS Selection Process

Our NHS chapter evaluates students on the 4 main pillars of NHS:

- **Scholarship**
  - **Service**
  - **Leadership**
  - **Character**
1. After the 1<sup>st</sup> 20 days of school, co-advisors are given a list of 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> students with a qualifying GPA for our chapter of NHS. MCHS has established a cumulative weighted 3.8 GPA as the minimum requirement.
  2. Those students are invited to complete a candidate packet.
  3. The NHS Faculty Council reviews all packets—assessing the remaining 3 areas:
    - a. Significant evidence of Leadership
    - b. Significant evidence of Service
    - c. Evidence of Strong Character
  4. All candidates are then notified as to whether or not they met the criteria in order to be inducted into our chapter of NHS.
  5. Induction ceremony is held for new inductees.
