#### 1. Online

- Click on "2018 Yearbook" and add yearbooks and donation amounts to your cart. Remember to
  enter your child's full name, grade and teacher name in the "Homeroom" box. For donations,
  enter "donation" in the first/last name boxes and "other" in the grade box. Major credit cards
  and Paypal accepted.

#### 2. On paper

- Complete the form below and turn it in to your child's teacher.
- If you are purchasing 2+ yearbooks for more than one child, clearly print each child's name, grade, and teacher.
- When you make a donation, please make a note on the order form below and on your check, payable to Root PTA.
