GEO BEE

Where in the world is Burundi or Micronesia? Do you know the locations of the National Parks in the USA? Where was the last World Cup played? We live in a global age! Through the Internet we can be connected to countries across the oceans. Do you want your child to know more about the bigger world outside of Raleigh, NC? You are in luck...the National Geographic GeoBee is back at Root this year!



In a fun, interactive way your child will learn about geography and other cultures through games and practice competitions. They will receive an atlas, websites with practice questions, and worksheets to study. The bi-monthly meetings are fun practices but not mandatory to participate in the competition which is for 4th and 5th grade students. The nationwide geography bee is sponsored by the National Geographic Society. For more information, please click **HERE**.

We welcome any 4th or 5th grader to join at any time. The club will meet on the following Tuesdays from 3:50-4:50 PM in Room 412 (Ms. Johnson's room): October 22, November 5, November 19, December 3, December 17 and January 14. There will be a mock GeoBee preceding the competition. The Root GeoBee will be held on or before January 24. The school winner will take the state champ qualifying test by Feb. 7. State champions may proceed to the national GeoBee held at the National Geographic Society in Washington, D.C. in the Spring of 2020.

The winner receives a \$50,000 scholarship, a lifetime subscription to National Geographic Magazine, a trip, and \$500 cash. The 2nd place winner receives a \$25,000 scholarship and \$500 cash. The 3rd place winner receives a \$10,000 scholarship and \$500 cash. The 4th-10th place winners receive \$500 cash prizes. Whether the students make it to the national GeoBee or not, they will all walk away with an increased awareness of our world and hopefully a sparked interest to learn more.

Black Box Dance Theatre is returning to Root this year on November 26! Black Box Theatre has performed for thousands across NC and is a favorite of both students and educators. Known for their nonfiction accounts of the world, the troupe has expertise in making dances that are relevant and inspirational to audiences of all ages. It matters who is dancing and what you are dancing about: this modern dance company includes a hip hop dancer, a ballerina, and a Purple Heart Army veteran all adding to the artistry on stage.

Students will learn about the history of modern dance and how it is one of the only art forms created in America. They will learn about shapes and how to move them with different qualities. They will learn how to "dance" a written paragraph, the physics of lifting with ease, and how to interpret a story without any words at all! Once the dance making process has been "de-mystified", it opens the door for each student to develop their unique ideas and creatively respond to the show.
