



SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

***DEADLINE:** December 20, 2017

DESCRIPTION: The Christ Saves Hearts Scholarship Program was established in 2016 to provide college scholarships to graduating NC Triangle high school seniors who have been directly affected by heart disease. The scholarships available are non-renewable awards of (one) \$1,000 scholarship and (two) \$500 scholarships. These scholarships will be applied to the cost of undergraduate tuition, fees, room and board, and other college expenses.

CRITERIA: To receive consideration, applicants must:

- Be African-American, Hispanic, or other minority
- Have a minimum cumulative unweighted GPA of 2.25
- Demonstrate financial need, but not restricted to lower family incomes (student's merit will be considered to a greater degree)
- Attend a U.S. accredited college or university beginning in the fall of 2018 in pursuit of a baccalaureate degree
- Reside in one of the following counties: Chatham, Durham, Johnston, Orange, or Wake

APPLICATION PROCESS: An electronic version of the application is available by emailing ChristSavesHearts@gmail.com. Submissions must be mailed to Christ Saves Hearts Foundation Inc. 7751 Brier Creek Pkwy., Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617 with a postmark dated on or before December 20, 2017 or emailed on or before December 20, 2017 to ChristSavesHearts@gmail.com. The following items must be submitted:

- Application completed in full with written essay
- High school transcript through the second semester of the 11th grade
- Two letters of recommendation – one academic and one personal (include why the applicant should receive the award)
- Any other supporting materials are optional (i.e. financial, media formats, etc.)

****The application and all supplemental materials must be received by the deadline above in order to be considered. Incomplete applications will not be considered.*

SELECTION PROCESS: A Scholarship Committee of The Christ Saves Hearts Foundation Inc. will select recipients. The committee reserves the right to rescind an award should a recipient's circumstances change, such as failure to graduate from high school or failure to enroll at an accredited institution. The Foundation reserves the right to withhold the award in the event that no applicants are deemed to meet the qualifications.

REQUIREMENTS AFTER SELECTION: Recipients must attend the Christ Saves Hearts Scholarship Gala on March 24, 2018 to receive one of the three awards. Recipients must maintain a GPA of 2.25 for the remainder of their senior year of high school. On or before July 1 st , 2018 , recipients must mail their final transcript after graduation and a copy of their college acceptance letter to Christ Saves Hearts Foundation Inc. 7751 Brier Creek Pkwy., Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617.

PAYMENT PROCESS: Once recipient(s) has been selected, checks will be issued jointly to the college and to the recipient, and will be mailed to the recipient's home address for the student to deliver to the college's financial aid office. Separate checks will be issued for fall and spring semesters. Check processing requires approximately two weeks.

MANAGEMENT OF FUND: The fame of Scholarship is administered by The Christ Saves Hearts Foundation Inc. As the fund grows, the number and dollar amount of scholarships may be increased. Questions regarding this scholarship may be directed to ChristSavesHearts@gmail.com.
