Thank you for supporting your child's reading at home. Teachers really did a great job promoting students to read. As a result, 70% of students in our school met their mark. We came in 3rd place in Wake County for books read at 16,158 books. We were the highest ranked Title I School in 3 counties. This was a great accomplishment and better yet, our students were very motivated and excited about reading!

ATTENDANCE: Many of our youngest students miss 10 percent of the school year—about 18 days a year or just two days every month. Chronic absenteeism in kindergarten can predict lower test scores, poor attendance and retention in later grades, especially if the problem persists for more than a year. - according to Attendance Works

Who is affected: ALL STUDENTS, but Kindergarten and 1st grade often have the highest absenteeism rates.

Why it matters: If children don't show up for school regularly, they miss out on fundamental reading and math skills and the chance to build a habit of good attendance that will carry them into college and careers.

What we can do: Engage families, fix transportation issues, address health needs and track the right data!
