We are excited to start the 2018-19 school year with our newly adopted Wake County curriculum. The new curriculum includes reading several novels around which critical lessons are developed. Throughout the school year your child's teacher will be providing students with these novels. Below is an outline of how we intend to maintain the the integrity of these new resources.

- School novels will be stamped with the LRMS school stamp.
- Students' books will be tracked through assigned numbers.
- Students must return the book with the number they were assigned.
- To maintain book condition, students are to keep the book in a plastic zip lock bag.
- Students' names should be written on the outside of the bag.
- Books not returned in good condition or books lost must be replaced by parents.

Parents may choose to replace a damaged or lost book in one of two ways. You may purchase the needed book replacement yourself or the school can replace the book for you at the following cost. Costs below include shipping.

- Inside Out and Back Again \$7.50
- <u>A Midsummer Night's Dream</u> \$6.50
- <u>A Mighty Long Way</u> \$13.50
- The Omnivore's Dilemma \$8.50

If your child would like to have their own copy to use and keep you may choose to purchase books yourself. All of these books can be purchased at Barnes & Noble or through Amazon. If you choose to purchase your own books please write your child's name in their book. In this case, please let your child's teacher know you are opting out of borrowing the school resources.
