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Mission Statement

River Oaks Middle School, as a center for learning, will equip our students with the academic, social, and behavioral skills they need to successfully compete in a global society in the 21st Century.

Vision Statement

River Oaks Middle School empowers students in an effort to reduce suspension, increase student achievement and improve school and classroom climate. We offer an involved and caring staff, a positive atmosphere and opportunities for parent involvement. Our school employs a variety of instructional and behavioral strategies in a technology integrated environment with a low student-teacher ratio. River Oaks Middle School students return to their base schools with strategies and tools which enable them to be successful.

Goal 1

By June 2016, 70% of all 6th, 7th, & 8th grade students will, with routine incorporation of research based literacy strategies in alignment with Common Core Elements, meet and/or exceed expected growth in Reading and Math.

Goal 2

By June 2016, our combined number of Out-of-School Suspensions (OSS) will be proportionally reduced by 6% from the 2014 level.

Goal 3

By 2016, the percentage of teachers who agree or strongly agree in the parent involvement, teacher support, and community response sections of the Teacher Working Conditions Survey (TWC) will increase to 75% or greater.
