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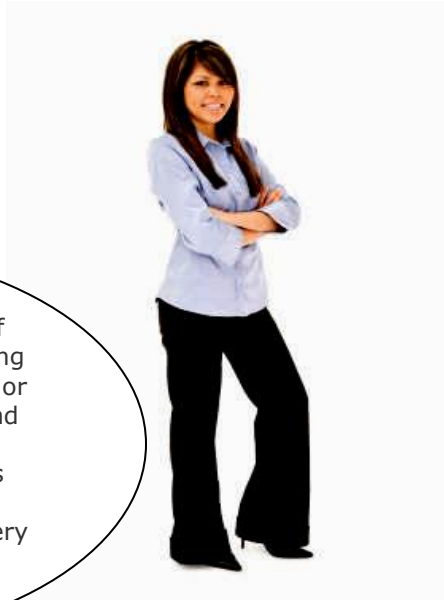
This young man is wearing a more casual option, but it's still suited well for an interview. A button down without a tie and nice, well-fitting khakis are an excellent option for young men.
