IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT STAGGERED ENTRY

- Please make sure to note what day your child will be coming for their staggered entry day.
- Please see attached form that <u>must</u> be sent in with your child on their staggered entry date. It is so important
 that we know how your child is getting home, any allergies they have, and who to contact in case of an
 emergency.
- Please bring school supplies to Meet the Teacher on Friday, August 30th.
- If your child is buying lunch please send in \$2.75. If your child is not buying lunch please send in a lunch for him or her, along with a healthy snack.

STAGGERED ENTRY

Our staggered entry program is designed to make a gradual transition from home to school. This process ensures your child's first day of school is calm and positive. Staggered entry means that kindergarten students only come to school one day during the first four days of the school year. This process gives the teachers time to greet and work with each child individually, calm fears, and give the initial battery of kindergarten assessment screenings. We will provide the warmth, security, and acceptance that each child needs. Our kindergarten screening will enable us to know your child well and provide an appropriate, challenging educational environment for him/her. Please check the chart below to identify the date your child will come to school the first week.

CHILD NUTRITION SERVICES

For your convenience, you may pre-pay for meals by the week or month. You may purchase meals daily or pay in advance with a check payable to the school cafeteria. In addition, Child Nutrition Services offers an automated prepayment plan that allows you to authorize a bank draft or credit card payment to the cafeteria automatically.
