SAIL Expectations
<p>Safety</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Use only apps, internet sites and slides provided by the teacher. 2. Students are expected to follow the Student Code of Conduct Board policy 6410, as well as Board policy 6446: Student Acceptable Use of Electronic Resources. Any violation may result in the loss of technology privileges at school, as well as other disciplinary action.
<p>Act Responsibly</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students take full responsibility for their devices. 2. Take your device home every night. 3. Keep your device parked if you are not using it. 4. Keep your device charged and ready! 5. Only use your device! 6. No personal texting/messaging 7. No devices on the playground, on the bus, or at any other non-instructional time. 8. Devices will not be used with a substitute teacher in a classroom. 9. If students forget devices at home, parents should not drop them off later to avoid interruption of instruction.
<p>Impress with Respect</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Respect and protect the privacy of others. Do not post photographs/videos of any person on campus to public or social networking for personal reasons. 2. Always display positive digital citizenship 3. Close screen or shutdown device immediately when asked. 4. Park your device immediately when asked. 5. Only use your device in device friendly classes (cannot take to recess, bathroom or cafeteria)
